

## Selected as the highest-rated A-List for CDP 2022 Climate-Change

The only construction company in A-List for the fifth consecutive year

Toda Corporation (headquarters: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President: Otani Seisuke) was selected for CDP 2022 Climate Change A List by CDP (Head Office: London), an international non-governmental organization that conducts environmental assessments, and was recognized as a leading global company in its activities and disclosures about climate change.

In 2022, 283 companies worldwide and 74 companies including us in Japan were selected as Climate Change A List. We are the only construction company to be a Climate Change A List for the fifth consecutive year since 2018.

## [Toda Corporation Initiatives]

We aim to reduce greenhouse gases in our business activities to virtually zero by 2050. We are working to reduce greenhouse gas emissions throughout the supply chain through the use of renewable energy in construction, the promotion of ZEB (net zero energy building), the decarbonization of construction materials, and the use of wood.

We have also worked to develop technologies for floating offshore wind turbine in order to contribute to the renewable energy as the major power source. Currently, Goto Floating Wind Farm LLC, of which we are representative, is constructing a floating offshore wind turbine with a 16.8MW (=2.1MW machine × 8 units) in Goto City, Nagasaki Prefecture, <sup>\*\*</sup> with commercial operation scheduled to begin in January 2024.

We will optimize our business portfolio by promoting strategic investments in key managed businesses and intangibles, which will be responsible for future growth. We will aim to achieve our medium-to longterm target of ROE 8% while striving to further improvement of our corporate value.
